What is "Wadaiko" ?

The Japanese drum is a percussion instrument used in festivals, Kabuki, Noh plays, and Ceremonies in Buddhist temples. It is made of leather on a body made from a tree, and it is made to vibrate. It can be struck with a drumstick and also hit with the hand. It is then called a hand drum or "Tsuzumi".

① Basic Lesson

After registering, put on a "happi", and the excitement starts. Learn how to hold the drum stick. The lesson starts from how to stand. To get accustomed to the Japanese drum, you strike it freely & slowly.

② Rhythm Lesson

After a little basic practice you have the rhythm lesson. You'll practice several traditional rhythms from Japanese kabuki, which have been used in a Samurai movie. The rhythms build into one song.

③ Announcement

You play the complete song and get a feel for being on the stage. Please enjoy the exhilarating feeling after a performance. Everybody is always able to do this so please don't worry.

④ Performance

The lecturer is a professional performer. They will be able to help everybody achieve a great performance experience.
